O OBJECTIVE

GREENIN project aim is to set up a desired scenario in green public procurement for innovation (GPPI) aligned with smart specialisation strategies, to increase knowledge exchange with policy makers and interested stakeholders, favouring SMEs participation. The **GREENIN** project intends to open a dialogue on how GPPI efforts and impact can be reinforced through a joint learning process of the three partners and to elaborate a suitable **Design Options Paper** (GREENIN DOP), creating a desired scenario for all those involved and interested in the policy topic in the future.

Identification, analysis and selection of policies, methodologies, experiences and good practices on GPPI



Guided discussions and work sessions with Local Working Groups to identify common applicable approaches for GPPI



Joint drafting of the GREENIN DOP for the definition of a desired scenario for GPPI



Regional pilot applications to facilitate dialogue and networking activities between procurers and SMEs



Organisation of a final workshop in Brussels to present the GREENIN DOP to other regions interested on GPPI
